

## **2010 GULF COAST PAINT CLASSIC FUTURITY BREEDERS FUTURITY RULES**

**As amended 18 NOVEMBER 2009**

### **II - FUTURITY RULES**

1. All owners and exhibitors of entries must be current members in good standing of Gulf Coast Paint Horse Club and APHA.
2. All futurity entries are limited to APHA registered or eligible horses.
3. By entering and exhibiting, owners/handlers acknowledge the right and give permission to the futurity committee to administer drug testing (blood and/or urine) of any or all entries, randomly or in any manner decided by the committee. APHA drug testing rules will be used as guidelines.
4. The rules of the Gulf Coast Paint Classic Futurity will govern all Futurity classes.
  
5. A legible copy of the registration certificate must be presented to the Futurity Committee with an entry form (properly completed) and payment of entry fees on or before August 15, 2010, to avoid late fees. The Gulf Coast Paint Horse Club cannot assume responsibility for typographical errors or the efficiency of the United States Postal Service or any other delivery service applicable to the delivery of entries to the Futurity Committee.
6. It is the responsibility of the participant to obtain and be aware of the rules governing the futurity.
7. Any entry must exhibit in all applicable go rounds to receive payback money.
8. A horse dismissed from a class for unsoundness WILL NOT be refunded any money nor receive any payback money.
9. Each class will be judged by four judges, to be drawn by the committee. Additionally, one of the four judges will be drawn to determine the tie breaker judge. In the case of a tie in a money paying position, the tie breaker judge will determine placing and monies and prizes will be awarded accordingly. Points from all four judges will count. Performance classes will be judged in one go round.
10. When all horses have been judged and placed each horse will receive points according to their position in which each was placed. 1<sup>st</sup> = 1 point, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 2 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 3 points, etc, and through the last place horse. The horse receiving the lowest placing cumulative score will be declared the winner of each applicable class.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

**YEARLING ELIGIBILITY (2010 FUTURITY):** Paint or Solid Paint Bred / Breeding Stock Yearlings must be sired by a stallion whose service was purchased in the stallion service sale in the previous stallion service auctions. Yearlings must be registered in the APHA regular or solid paint bred / breeding stock registry. A copy of the papers must accompany the entry or the entry will be considered a late entry.

**2-YEAR-OLD ELIGIBILITY (2010 FUTURITY):** Paint or Solid Paint Bred / Breeding Stock 2-year-olds must be sired by a stallion whose service was purchased in the previous stallion service auctions. 2 year olds must be registered in the regular or solid paint bred / breeding stock registry. A copy of the papers must accompany the entry or the entry will be considered a late entry.

**HALTER:**

**PERFORMANCE:**

**PURSES:** The purse for Yearling Halter, Yearling Longe Line, 2 year old Snaffle Bit or any other class as offered by the club will consist of 80% of entry fees, including late fees, plus “added money” as determined by the club.

No money will be paid until all checks have cleared the bank. Returned checks will be charged \$50. plus any related bank charges and entry will be assessed a late fee.

If a futurity entry is ill, lame, or the owner is ill or has other extenuating circumstances the Futurity Committee will consider a refund of fees received on a case by case basis. Appropriate documentation will be required in all cases. However, a horse dismissed from a class for unsoundness will not be refunded any money nor receive any payback money. If a participant picks up the Futurity entry number and chooses not to show or misses the class, there will be no refund of fees and the money will remain in the purse for that entry and that class.

No substitutions will be allowed for any reason.

Payback will be awarded based on the number of entries shown in the class. Prize moneys will be paid to the current owner of the entry as listed on the registration certificate or breeder’s certificate at the time of the futurity judging, unless otherwise instructed by the owner. The Social security number applicable to the payee is required to receive payback money. Prize money should be paid within four weeks of the conclusion of the futurity.
