



CTPHC General Show Rules 2010



1. The horse must be registered with the American Paint Horse Association.
2. The owner of a horse must be a Central Texas Paint Horse Club member at the time points are won. CTPHC membership year is January 1 to December 31. If the horse is sold, the points (Open ONLY) will transfer and continue to accrue when the new owner joins the CTPHC, if not already a member.
3. Youth, Novice Youth, Amateur, and Novice Amateur exhibitors must present a current Youth, Youth Novice Amateur, or Novice Amateur card when entering a class and must record their Youth, Youth Novice Amateur, or Novice Amateur number on ALL entry forms.
 - 3a. All Youth and Amateur High Point Awards will be tallied on a one-horse, one-rider basis. Lead line and Walk-Trot will be the only exception, with points tallied on the rider only.
4. All awards will be given depending on the financial status of the club at the end of each year as determined by the Board of Directors.

5. To be eligible for Open, Amateur, or Youth, Youth Novice Year-end Awards, a member must contribute two hours of club service at the CTPHC Show in May or the Zone 4 Zone-O-Rama. In lieu of providing the two hours of service, a payment of \$150.00 may be made to the CTPHC Treasurer by the close of the Zone 4 Show. Members will be notified of CTPHC approved shows sponsored by other Texas Clubs which will also count for CTPHC points via website and newsletters.
6. For an Open horse to qualify for the Year-end All-Around Award, a horse must compete in open halter and at least three of categories II through VI as listed in APHA Rule SC-050.3 Halter Grand Champions will receive two additional points and Reserve Champions one additional point. The horse must be shown in at least the same three (3) events under at least 50% of the judges at CTPHC sponsored or approved shows and having shown in at least one of CTPHCs' sponsored shows (**CTPHC Show in May**). All Open points earned during the show year at sponsored and approved shows will count toward the Open All-Round Award. . No Points When Disqualified. No points are to be awarded to a disqualified horse.
7. For Youth (13& U, 14-18) or Amateur exhibitors to qualify for the Year-end High Point Awards, the exhibitor/ horse must compete in the appropriate Youth or Amateur division halter and at least three (3) performance events. The exhibitor/horse must show in at least the same three (3) performance events under at least 50% of the judges at CTPHC sponsored or approved shows. An additional qualification requirement for year-end awards is that exhibitor/horse must have shown in at least one of CTPHCs' sponsored shows (**CTPHC Show in May**). The judges for these approved shows obviously count as part of the 50%. All Youth and Amateur points earned during the show year at sponsored and approved shows will count toward the Youth or Amateur High Point Award. No Points When Disqualified. No points are to be awarded to a disqualified horse.
8. For Youth Walk-trot exhibitors to qualify for the Year-end High Point Awards, the exhibitor must compete in at least three Walk-Trot events (Halter does not count). The exhibitor/horse must show in at least the same three (3) events under at least 50% of the judges at CTPHC sponsored or approved shows and having shown in at least one of CTPHCs' sponsored shows (**CTPHC Show in May**). All Walk-trot points earned during the show year at sponsored and approved shows will count toward the Walk-trot High Point Award. . No Points When Disqualified. No points are to be awarded to a rider. Walk- Trot exhibitors may not enter any other classes requiring a lope or a canter.
9. For Novice Youth or Novice Amateur exhibitors to qualify for the Year-end High Point Awards, the exhibitor must compete in at least three Novice Youth or Novice Amateur events (Halter does not count). The exhibitor/horse must show in at least the same three (3) events under at least 50% of the judges at CTPHC sponsored or approved shows and having shown in at least one of CTPHCs' sponsored shows (**CTPHC Show in May**). All Novice Youth or Novice Amateur points earned during the show year at

sponsored and approved shows will count toward the Novice Youth or Novice Amateur High Point Award. . No Points When Disqualified. No points are to be awarded to a disqualified horse.

10. For individual class year-end award, the Open horse, Youth, Novice Youth, Novice Amateur, or Amateur having shown in at least one of CTPHCs' sponsored shows (**CTPHC Show in May**), and shown to at least 50% of all judges in the combination of sponsored and approved shows, and having earned a minimum of 10 club points must be earned for Grand Champion and a minimum of 8 club points must be earned for Reserve Champion in that class, the High Point in that event will be the horse/ rider- horse combination with the most points earned during the show year at sponsored and approved shows. The exception to this rule will be weanlings, two-year-old riding classes (English and Western) and the most points earned during the show year at sponsored and approved shows will determine class winners. No Points When Disqualified- No points are to be awarded to a rider.

11. The following point system will be used in calculating club awards,

12. Ties will be broken for Year-end Awards and/or Show High Point as follows:

13. Entries must be made before the class begins. Entry forms must be completely filled out and signed.

13a. Show management reserves the right to drug test at random at any time at any CTPHC show.

14. Awards not picked up at the CTPHC show or have no arrangements made will be forfeited for that CTPHC show.

15. APHA rules will be followed according to the current APHA rule book.
